

PGA Sports Academy

The PGA Sports Academy program focuses on helping youth learn to play golf while having fun throughout three levels: Player, Sport, and Champion. Get Golf Ready



Get Golf Ready is the "bunny slope" for adults wanting to learn how to golf. The program is designed to teach everything one needs to play golf in just a handful of lessons. Comprised of five lessons, Get Golf Ready gives individuals the information necessary to become comfortable on the course

and with their golf swing. Using Tee It Forward, the program encourages players to have fun in a more relaxed and social atmosphere. Starting a Get Golf Ready program at your course will build involvement in your golf program by bringing new individuals to the game!

PGA Junior League

Different from other junior golf tours and events, PGA Junior League Golf is a fun and social opportunity for boys and girls under the age of 13. Similar to other recreational league sports, golfers wear numbered jerseys and play on teams with



their friends. Each game consists of four 9-hole matches played in two-person scramble format. As a PGA Professional, you act as a Captain to a Junior League team. This is simple to do, just by going to the link below and registering yourself. After that, the fun begins – you get to set up your team, assign coaches, and organize matches with other local teams.
