Letter From Chip Clover, Western New York PGA Presdient

Whether you're playing in few events or all of them this season you can expedite the time in which you receive your winnings by signing up for direct deposit. Go to westernNewYork.pga.com and then click on the tournaments tab. Once there you will see the instructions for downloading the direct deposit form. Fill out this form and then fax it back to Dee Jersey at the PGA of America.

The PGA of America's check writer comes out of Oregon so it may take 3-to 5 days to reach you once the event has been played. With direct deposit you will receive your winnings deposited directly to your bank account on the next day and in some cases on the same day the event was played. There are no fees involved and the form takes only a few minutes to fill out!

I would encourage all of our tournament players to register for their respective events by using one of two methods of payment on our on-line tournament registration. Paying by credit card at time of registration is one method and paying by check (to the section office) after registering on line is the other. If you are paying by check after registering on line, please send your check to the section office immediately after registering. When our section staff is present at a tournament site, our goal is to allow them to be fully engaged in the execution of the event and not worrying about keeping track of player's entry fee checks on the day of the event. Your cooperation will be greatly appreciated.

It is that time of year to remind each of you that your PGA Dues are due by June 15th. Please don't treat this like we do with our taxes and wait until the very last moment to hand over our money, do it right now while it is fresh in your mind.

Finally, I'm pleased to report to all of you that the Western New York Section PGA Foundation has received its official charter. Planning will begin with our committee in the late summer-early fall period to begin our fundraising plans for 2011. It is my sincere hope that many of you will want to be involved in helping our Foundation grow and become successful in its growth. Our ultimate goal is to begin issuing grants in 2012 to groups like inner city youth golf, golfers with disabilities, Special Olympics and the like. Employment Briefs from Tom Kendrick, PGA Employment Consultant

In the last *Employment Briefs* I was discussing what employers look for in their PGA Professional and examined the three broad skill set categories of The Game, The People and The Business. In this issue, I will drill down looking at some of the specific competencies most valued by today's employers, please consider the following:

- Customer service Happy, satisfied customers have always been important, now however, they are a financial and strategic necessity. Surveys show that the cost of retaining customers is much less than replacing them. Analysis indicates that increasing the frequency of play among existing golfers is the most cost effective marketing available.
- Marketing and promotion With the number of golfers remaining static, finding new, creative ways to attract new players
 and stimulate additional activity among current members is a characteristic that is sought after. This mirrors what other
 hospitality businesses refer to as "yield management" or "tee sheet supervision." In the past, for some, marketing began
 and ended with discounting. While many still feel obligated to mark down fees, they have learned it may not be effective
 and can not be relied upon for long term financial health. Facilities have learned to better manage when and to whom
 they offer price concessions.
- Budget development and management. Formerly, at a minimum, it was important to be able to manage a budget. Now it
 is critical not only to develop and manage budgets, but to also be prepared to make creative corrective adjustments on a
 weekly and even daily basis. A term that is heard frequently is "managing to the bottom line' which requires being personally accountable for the department's performance.

After reviewing these three competencies, how do you stack up? I'll explore some additional competencies in the next issue of Employment Briefs.


